# **Pneumatology: PART II**

## **The Study of the Holy Spirit**

**28And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues. 1 Corinthians 12:28**

God sets spiritual gifts in order in the church: I Corinthians 12:28

**Not everyone has the same gift:** I Corinthians 12:28-30

**We should desire spiritual gifts.** I Corinthians 12:31; 14:1

**Love is the key to using all gifts:** I Corinthians 13

**Gifts should edify the church:** I Corinthians 14:12

### **SPECIAL GIFTS**

The first group of spiritual gifts are what we will call "special gifts." We use this title for these gifts because each one is a special leadership position in the church:

**And He gave some, apostles; and some, prophets, and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers. (Ephesians 4:11)**

These leadership positions are sometimes called "offices" in the church. "Office" means

a place of responsibility and duty. The special leadership gifts are:

**-Apostles**

**-Prophets**

**-Evangelists**

**-Pastors**

**-Teachers**

## **APOSTLES**

An apostle is one who has a special ability to develop new churches in different places and cultures and to oversee a number of churches as a supervisor. Apostle means "a delegate, one sent with full power and authority to act for another." The apostle has a special authority or ability to extend the Gospel throughout the world by developing organized bodies of believers. Modern terms used by the church for an apostle are missionary and church-planter.

## **PROPHETS**

There are two prophetic gifts. One is the special gift of being a prophet. The other is the speaking gift of prophecy. In general, prophecy refers to speaking under the special inspiration of God. It is the special ability to receive and communicate an immediate message of God to His people through a divinely-anointed utterance. To this point, the definition applies to the special leadership gift of a prophet as well as the speaking gift of prophecy. But a person is not a prophet just because he prophesies.

The difference between a prophet and prophesying is apparent in the following passage:

**And the next day we that were of Paul's company departed, and came unto Caesarea; and we entered into the house of Philip the evangelist, which was one of the seven; and abode with him. And the same man had four daughters, virgins, which did prophesy. And as we tarried there many days, there came down from**

### **Judaea a certain prophet, named Agabus. (Acts 21:8-11)**

Philip's daughters had the speaking gift of prophesy. But **Agabus** was a prophet who not only gave prophetic messages but held a leadership position in the church. God used him in a leadership role regarding Paul's ministry. **Agabus** gave Paul spiritual direction regarding what would happen in Jerusalem (**Acts 21:11**). Those with the special gift of being a prophet do not just speak under the inspiration of God. They also hold an office of authority and leadership in the church. This is confirmed in **Acts 13:1-4** where prophets and teachers were used in a leadership capacity to guide Barnabas and Saul into the special ministry to which God had called them.

## **EVANGELISTS**

An evangelist has a special ability to share the Gospel with non-believers in a way that men and women respond and become responsible members of the Body of Christ. The meaning of the word "evangelist" is "one who brings good news." Although all believers are to "do the work of an evangelist" and share the Gospel with others, God gives some the special gift of being an evangelist. Philip was one who had the spiritual gift of being an evangelist:

**And the next day we that were of Paul's company departed, and came unto Caesarea; and we entered in to the house of Philip the evangelist... (Acts 21:8)**

## **PASTORS**

"pastor" actually means shepherd. (The New Testament was originally written in Greek). Pastors are leaders who assume long-term personal responsibility for the spiritual welfare of a group of believers. Because the word means shepherd, pastors should follow the example set by Jesus Christ as a "pastor" or "shepherd" of people:

## **TEACHERS**

Teachers are believers who have the special ability of communicating the Word of God effectively in such a way that others learn and apply what is taught. Teaching involves training, not just communicating information.

**The five special gifts of leadership function together in the ministry of the church.**

## **Apostles**

extend the Gospel message to various regions and raise up organized bodies of believers. God gives special miraculous signs and wonders to assist in this extension of the Gospel. The apostle provides special leadership to the churches he raises up.

## **Prophets**

also provide leadership in the church. One of their functions is to give special messages from God through the inspiration of the Holy Spirit.

## **Evangelists**

communicate the Gospel in such a manner that people respond to it and become believers. They may minister individually or in large groups, but their ministry always produces new believers. These believers then come under the care of apostles, prophets, pastors, and teachers of the church who guide their spiritual development. The example of Philip in Acts chapter 8 illustrates this. He brought the Samaritans to Christ, then turned them to the apostles for further teaching.

## **Pastors**

exercise long-term leadership and care for those who have believed through the message of the evangelist. They provide pastoral care to those who have become believers through the ministry of apostles. Their ministry is a picture of the loving care of a shepherd for his sheep.

## **Teachers**

provide instruction which goes beyond the presentation of the Gospel by the evangelist. They teach believers to be spiritually mature. They train faithful people who are capable of teaching others. The main responsibility of those with special leadership gifts is to train other believers to discover and use their spiritual gifts (Ephesians 4:11-16).

# **The Holy Spirit With the Evidence of Speaking in Tongues 7 Biblical Facts**

**1. It empowers us to be a witness for Christ.**

**8But ye shall receive power, AFTER that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth. Acts 1:8**

**2. Speaking in tongues is the outward sign we have been filled.**

**4And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. Acts 2:4**

When a Believer is filled with the Holy Spirit the outward sign, or evidence of being filled, is that you will be able to speak in tongues, or our Heavenly language. The Holy Spirit gives the utterance, while our tongues through our willing submission, and free becomes an instrument the Holy Spirit uses to speak through. The individual who speaks in tongues is always in control and can speak in their Heavenly Language at will and stop at will (see 1 Corinthians 14:32) but the Holy Spirit is the one who gives us the Supernatural words to speak.

**3. It brings Spiritual edification.**

**4He that speaketh in an unknown tongue edifieth himself; but he that prophesieth edifieth the church. 1 Corinthians 14:4**

When we speak in tongues we are being edified and built up in our most Holy Faith, we are literally being strengthened by the Holy spirit and our spirit becomes stronger than our flesh and our minds. The more we speak in tongues the more we will be strengthened.

This scripture reveals the two arenas of speaking in tongues.

1. The Private where we are Edified and strengthened by the Holy Spirit. Personally.
2. The Public where we prophecy and bring edification to others publicly.

We have already learned that not everyone will operate in the public side of tongues. But every single believer can and should operate in the private side of tongues.

#### **4. Only God can understand your prayers.**

**2For he that speaketh in an unknown tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth him; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries. 1 Corinthians 14:2**

When we pray in tongues only God understands what we are saying, not men, not angels, not the devil, only God. we are speaking forth mysteries. These are things that the Holy Spirit within us knows that we need to become the man or woman God has called us to be. When we pray in Tongues the Holy Spirit through us is praying for exactly what we need, in the perfect way and manner we should pray for it.

#### **5. Praying in tongues is praying in accordance with God's perfect will .**

**26Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. Romans 8:26**

Sometimes we don't know what we should pray for. Especially in very difficult situations. It is in these times especially we can pray in Tongues and the Holy Spirit will pray the perfect prayer through us, interceding for us, through this Heavenly language. What a wonderful gift !

#### **6. Praying in tongues will build up your Faith.**

**20But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost, Jude1:20**

Praying in the Spirit will build up and strengthen our faith. Often times when I need some encouragement or if I am going through a tough time. I will set aside an hour or two and just pray, and praise god, in my prayer Language. And every time I come out of that experience, I have been in God's presence, I am refreshed, and strengthened in my spirit, and my mind. Glory be to God !

7. Praying in tongues keeps you filled and full of God's presence.

**18And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled** (continually being filled, original Greek) **with the Spirit; 19Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord; 20Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ; Ephesians 5:18-20**

When we speak in tongues we are literally filling our spirits up to the brim with God's glory, God's presence, and God's power. The more we speak in our Heavenly Language the greater God's presence, and the stronger our faith, will become. Those who will make the sacrifice of praise, by daily speaking in Tongues, will walk in the supernatural Manifestation of God's Supernatural Signs and Wonders.

## **Interpretation Of Tongues**

**1**Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I would not have you ignorant. **2**Ye know that ye were Gentiles, carried away unto these dumb idols, even as ye were led. **3**Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and that no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost. **4**Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. **5**And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord. **6**And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all. **7**But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. **8**For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; **9**To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; **10**To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: **11**But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will. **1 Corinthians 12:1-11**

## **WORD OF WISDOM**

**Definition :** A supernatural revelation given to an individual, by God, to convey to a person or a people a Future Event.

The Spiritual gift of the word of wisdom always reveals a future event that has not yet taken place yet. It may manifest because God wants to inform people about something that is going to happen in the future, or possibly as a warning of a coming future disaster or event. The wisdom that comes through this gift is not learned or known by our natural ability it is insight given to us directly from the mind of God, through the Holy Spirit.

**11**And the Lord said unto him, Arise, and go into the street which is called Straight, and inquire in the house of Judas for one called Saul, of Tarsus: for, behold, he prayeth, **12**And hath seen in a vision a man named Ananias coming in, and putting his hand on him, that he might receive his sight. **13**Then Ananias answered, Lord, I have heard by many of this man, how much evil he hath done to thy saints at Jerusalem: **14**And here he hath authority from the chief priests to bind all that call on thy name. **15**But the Lord said unto him, Go thy way: for he is a chosen vessel unto me, to bear my name before the Gentiles, and kings, and the children of Israel: **16**For I will shew him how great things he must suffer for my name's sake. **17**And Ananias went his way, and entered into the house; and putting his hands on him said, Brother Saul, the Lord, even Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me, that thou mightest receive thy sight, and be filled with

**the Holy Ghost. Acts 9:11-17**

## **WORD OF KNOWLEDGE**

**Definition :** The word of Knowledge is exactly like a word of wisdom. The difference being A Word Of Knowledge reveals a past or present event. Not Future.

**1But a certain man named Ananias, with Sapphira his wife, sold a possession, 2And kept back part of the price, his wife also being privy to it, and brought a certain part, and laid it at the apostles' feet. 3But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land? 4Whiles it remained, was it not thine own? and after it was sold, was it not in thine own power? why hast thou conceived this thing in thine heart? thou hast not lied unto men, but unto God. 5And Ananias hearing these words fell down, and gave up the ghost: and great fear came on all them that heard these things. 6And the young men arose, wound him up, and carried him out, and buried him. 7And it was about the space of three hours after, when his wife, not knowing what was done, came in. 8And Peter answered unto her, Tell me whether ye sold the land for so much? And she said, Yea, for so much. 9Then Peter said unto her, How is it that ye have agreed together to tempt the Spirit of the Lord? behold, the feet of them which have buried thy husband are at the door, and shall carry thee out. 10Then fell she down straightway at his feet, and yielded up the ghost: and the young men came in, and found her dead, and, carrying her forth, buried her by her husband. Acts 5:1-10**

## **DISCERNING OF SPIRITS**

**Definition :** Supernatural insight into the spirit world or realm of the spirit. This Spiritual gift gives us Divine insight into what type of spirit we are dealing with in a particular situation.

**Divine** , This is the Holy Spirit and He is God, and always acts on the Fathers will.

**Satanic** , These are evil spirits sent by & subject to Satan, they carry out Satan's will.

**Human** , we as humans have our own Human spirit, as we were created in God's image.

One time several years ago, I was teaching a small Bible class and one night this lady walked into the classroom. I had never seen her before but The very moment she walked into the meeting I had an overwhelming sense of Satanic presence and a very cold feeling came upon me. My first thought was, **“Oh Great, now there's a witch in my class.”** This lady caused many distractions and disruptions, she even threatened some of the other participants outside of classroom. I had to have this woman removed from the building because she was causing such an uproar. Later on, I discovered that this woman had been going to different churches and disrupting them and causing havoc. But the Holy Spirit revealed to me what I was dealing with the very moment she walked in the room. I found out much later that this woman was well known in the area for practicing witchcraft.

**6And when they had gone through the isle unto Paphos, they found a certain sorcerer, a false prophet, a Jew, whose name was Barjesus: 7Which was with the deputy of the country, Sergius Paulus, a prudent man; who called for Barnabas and Saul, and desired to hear the word of God. 8But Elymas the sorcerer (for so is his name by interpretation) withstood them, seeking to turn away the deputy from the faith. 9Then Saul, (who also is called Paul,) filled with the Holy Ghost, set his eyes on him. 10And said, O full of all subtilty and all mischief, thou child of the devil, thou enemy of all righteousness, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord? 11And now, behold, the hand of the Lord is upon thee, and thou shalt be blind, not seeing the sun for a season. And immediately there fell on him a mist and a darkness; and he went about seeking some to lead him by the hand. 12Then the deputy, when he saw what was done, believed, being astonished at the doctrine of the Lord. Acts 13:6-12**

## **THE GIFT OF FAITH**

**Description :** A supernatural endowment by the Spirit, a Supernatural trust and or belief in God for the miraculous.

There are three types of faith

**Saving faith** (see Ephesians 2:8-9)

This is the faith God gives to all people at what I believe their time of birth. It is this initial impartation of faith one uses to except Christ as Lord and savior.

**Faith by hearing** (see Romans 10:17)

We can also receive faith by hearing God’s written word. This type of faith comes by our

pursuit and intake of the Word of God.

### **The Gift of Faith**

This is a Spiritual gift, you can not get it, or learn it, it just comes upon you in an overwhelming and Supernatural way. It is above and beyond the measure of faith you currently have. This type of faith usually comes upon us, or manifests, in times of great spiritual battle, or times when a miracle is needed in order to change a situation, person, or thing.

**36**Now there was at Joppa a certain disciple named Tabitha, which by interpretation is called Dorcas: this woman was full of good works and almsdeeds which she did. **37**And it came to pass in those days, that she was sick, and died: whom when they had washed, they laid her in an upper chamber. **38**And forasmuch as Lydda was nigh to Joppa, and the disciples had heard that Peter was there, they sent unto him two men, desiring him that he would not delay to come to them. **39**Then Peter arose and went with them. When he was come, they brought him into the upper chamber: and all the widows stood by him weeping, and shewing the coats and garments which Dorcas made, while she was with them. **40**But Peter put them all forth, and kneeled down, and prayed; and turning him to the body said, Tabitha, arise. And she opened her eyes: and when she saw Peter, she sat up. **41**And he gave her his hand, and lifted her up, and when he had called the saints and widows, presented her alive. **42**And it was known throughout all Joppa; and many believed in the Lord. **43**And it came to pass, that he tarried many days in Joppa with one Simon a tanner. Acts 9:36-43

Another story is of a man called Smith Wiggles worth, one of my spiritual heroes, an Englishman, who walked in a great anointing during the early and middle twentieth century. One day Wiggles worth walked into a funeral home where his friend lie dead in the casket. Wiggles worth picked his friend up out of the casket and placed him upright against the wall, Wiggles worth punched him in the stomach and commanded him to live, the man fell lifeless to the floor, once again Wiggles worth commanded the man to live, and once again he fell to the floor, finally Wiggles worth picked this dead man up again, Punched him in the stomach, and said I said I command you to live. But this time the man did not fall, he rose up from the dead and walked out of the funeral home alive and well alongside his friend Wiggles worth. This is a modern day example of the gift of faith in action. The first time the man fell to the ground many would have ran out, the second time we probably would have feared being arrested, but Wiggles worth kept on trusting God until this man finally came back from the grave itself.

## THE WORKING OF MIRACLES

**Definition :** A Supernatural intervention of the natural order of things, an interruption of the system of nature, by the force of the Spirit of God.

The Greek word for Miracles is Dunamis, from which we derive our English word Dynamite. The working of miracles is literally an explosion of God's supernatural Power. When this gift manifests God's power actually works through an individual, You actually handle the tangible power of God. While as the gift of faith can bring about a miracle, it is passive, it is God doing something for us. Whereas the working of miracles is a force, and is actively working THROUGH US. To bring about a miracle.

**22**And straightway Jesus constrained his disciples to get into a ship, and to go before him unto the other side, while he sent the multitudes away. **23**And when he had sent the multitudes away, he went up into a mountain apart to pray: and when the evening was come, he was there alone. **24**But the ship was now in the midst of the sea, tossed with waves: for the wind was contrary. **25**And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went unto them, walking on the sea. **26**And when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out for fear. **27**But straightway Jesus spake unto them, saying, Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid. **28**And Peter answered him and said, Lord, if it be thou, bid me come unto thee on the water. **29**And he said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus. **30**But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me. **31**And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt? **32**And when they were come into the ship, the wind ceased. **33**Then they that were in the ship came and worshiped him, saying, Of a truth thou art the Son of God. **34**And when they were gone over, they came into the land of Gennesaret. **35**And when the men of that place had knowledge of him, they sent out into all that country round about, and brought unto him all that were diseased; **36**And besought him that they might only touch the hem of his garment: and as many as touched were made perfectly whole. **Matthew 14:22-37**

The working of miracles turns the impossible into the possible. Peter walked on water, this was a miracle. He is always criticized because he sunk when his eyes were moved from faith to the problem. But I didn't see any other Disciples get out of the boat and try.

Peter walking on the water was a working of a miracle, we can see through this scripture that usually faith and miracles will go hand in hand. Most of the time miracles will not work without faith also being present at the same time.

(Also see Jesus turning water into wine in John 2:1-11 as another example of this spiritual gift in operation.)

## **THE GIFTS OF HEALING**

**Definition :** Supernatural healing of disease without natural means of any source.

The purpose of the gifts of healing is to deliver and heal the sick and to destroy the works of the devil in the human mind and or body. All healing does not come through the Gifts of healing, there are many different ways to be healed. We will not go into them here, For now we will concentrate on this Spiritual gift.

**6And the people with one accord gave heed unto those things which Philip spake, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did. 7For unclean spirits, crying with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed with them: and many taken with palsies, and that were lame, were healed. Acts 8:6-7**

**12And by the hands of the apostles were many signs and wonders wrought among the people..... Acts 5:12**

## **PROPHECY**

**Definition :** A supernatural utterance in a known tongue.

When one gives a prophecy he or she is speaking forth, supernaturally, the mind and will of God. A prophetic word comes through a person, to a group of people. It should always bring edification, a prophecy builds up, stirs up, and cheers up. We should have a prophetic word in our church services on a regular basis the word even tells us we should never despise prophecy.

**20Despise not prophesying 1 Thessalonians 5:20**

**3But he that prophesieth speaketh unto men to edification, and exhortation, and comfort. 1 Corinthians 14:3**

Prophecy is a good thing, and it is from God. But must be used as directed in the word of God. Some have abused this gift and caused many problems in the church. But we should not fear this, only be informed on how to operate in it and what to do and what not to do, so that prophecy remains a blessing to the Body of Christ.

## **GUIDELINES AND HOW PROPHECY WORKS**

The person operating in the gift is responsible for it's use, misuse, suppression, and control.

**26How is it then, brethren? when ye come together, every one of you hath a psalm, hath a doctrine, hath a tongue, hath a revelation, hath an interpretation. Let all things be done unto edifying. 27If any man speak in an unknown tongue, let it be by two, or at the most by three, and that by course; and let one interpret. 28But if there be no interpreter, let him keep silence in the church; and let him speak to himself, and to God. 29Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge. 30If any thing be revealed to another that sitteth by, let the first hold his peace. 31For ye may all prophesy one by one, that all may learn, and all may be comforted. 32And the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets. 33For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints. 1 Corinthians 14:26-33**

If we follow these Biblical guidelines we will all be blessed and edified by a prophetic word given to us in a public church gathering. It is people who run wild and cause confusion not God. That is why we must follow His instruction on how to operate in this gift. Many Pastors have rejected prophecy for fear of loosing control, this is not a good idea as you are rejecting God's gift. If Pastors would inform the people of the Gifts and their proper use, as described in the Bible, It will be a great blessing to you and your church !

## **DIVERSE KINDS OF TONGUES**

**Definition :** Supernatural utterance in an unknown tongue.

The operation of Speaking in tongues edifies our spirits and builds our faith, this is the private side of tongues, as we have already seen.

This spiritual gift we are now looking at is the public side of speaking in tongues. It is where a man or woman will speak in tongues in a public meeting such as church or a Bible study, and then most of the time there will come an interpretation of those tongues, so that the congregation may understand what was spoken to them and thus be edified. The Holy Spirit desires to manifest Himself in a vocal way. One way He does this is through Divers kinds of tongues. The words spoken in tongues are not understood by the speaker nor by the hearers, unless accompanied by An interpretation of tongues.

**9Whom shall he teach knowledge? and whom shall he make to understand doctrine? them that are weaned from the milk, and drawn from the breasts. 10For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little: 11For with stammering lips and another tongue will he (God) speak to this people. Isaiah 28:9-11**

## **INTERPRETATION OF TONGUES**

**Definition :** To show forth the meaning of Divers Kinds Of Tongues.

This is the only of the nine gifts that is not independent on it's own but is dependent upon the manifestation of another gift (Divers Kinds Of Tongues) in order to operate.

**11Therefore if I know not the meaning of the voice, I shall be unto him that speaketh a barbarian, and he that speaketh shall be a barbarian unto me. 12Even so ye, forasmuch as ye are zealous of spiritual gifts, seek that ye may excel to the edifying of the church.13Wherefore let him that speaketh in an unknown tongue pray that he may interpret. 1 Corinthians 14:11-13**

Many have said tongues bring confusion and disorder, but this is not true. If applied as the Bible says, they are a great and wonderful spiritual gift. The Holy Spirit will speak to us in two ways vocally. Here is a formula to remember them.

**A word from God** spoken in your known language through your mouth = **Prophecy**

## **Tongues + Interpretation of tongues = Prophecy**

Each of the nine gifts of the Spirit are wonderful and each serves an important purpose. The Holy Spirit wants to manifest in our lives, and He wants to use each of us to bring Glory to God.

### **IF YOU HAVE NEVER SPOKEN IN TONGUES, NOW IS A GREAT TIME TO START**

**Instructions:** The most important thing is to just yield to God and trust Him. Being filled with the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in other tongues is not a hard thing, it's not a weird thing, it is Jesus' gift to us.

John 16:7 I tell you the truth; it is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I WILL SEND HIM UNTO YOU.

**If you want to receive** Jesus' gift, the Holy Spirit, I would like to show you how to receive that gift now. Follow these steps and you will be filled and speaking in tongues in less than 60 seconds.

### **Follow These Simple Steps.**

Step 1. repent of any sin

Step 2. have an attitude of yielded ness to God

Step 3. pray the following prayer below and then do step 4

step 4. when you finish praying take a deep breath in as deep as you can and whatever you hear in your head no matter how weird you think it sounds. Say what you hear out loud (not English) **yield to God** and speak **OUT LOUD whatever you hear.** and you

will speak in tongues

## **PRAYER**

Jesus I want to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit that you promised to me. I ask that the Holy Ghost would come upon me and fill me with His presence and power with the evidence of speaking in tongues. Holy Spirit I receive you. **IN JESUS NAME, COME UPON ME NOW !**

**Take in a deep breath and begin to speak OUT LOUD whatever you hear. Not English**

Now that you have been filled with the Holy Ghost speak in your new prayer language every day, remember you are in control the Holy Spirit gives You the words but it is your mouth that does the speaking. As you continue to pray in tongues daily you will be built up and strengthened in the Spirit, God bless you.
